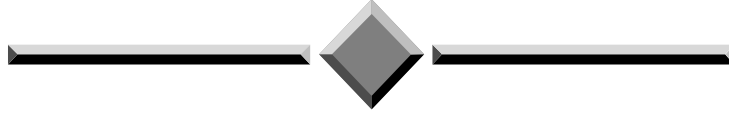


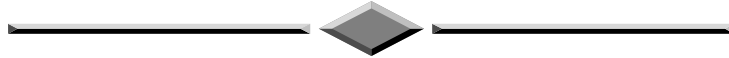

Current Work:

Chippy's Labourer from September this year till present I have been labouring for a builder on a 2 story house. Starting from the foundations to almost a finish product I have gained knowledge on many aspects of the building industry. I have been involved in using many power tools working on all types of materials. During this time we have had to liaise with Work Cover Inspectors and Building Inspectors to make sure we operated within OH&S standards.

Previous Work Experience:

- **El Questro Wilderness Park** from April 2011 till September 2011 I worked on a million acre property in the East Kimberly in WA. On the property I was employed as a Ranger/Tour guide/Coxswain, in this role I was skippering a 13 metre shallow draft vessel powered by a 14hp water jet engine which held up to 48 passengers and 2 crew at any one time, 6 times a day up a gorge system of 3km's. I was also in charge of over 20 hire Tinnies with battery's/motors which I was regularly performing maintenance on to ensure they were right for our clients. Being a Ranger entitled me to undertake various roles including weed eradication programs, helping with the running of the station for over 50,000 guests that we looked after in a period of 7 months, clearing of all walking trails. I also had to have a sound understanding of the local flora and fauna to talk about on many one on one tours that the job required.
- **Commercial Fishing Vessel "Jordan Kate"** from February 2010 till March 2011, I was a deckhand on this vessel. My duties on the boat involved making new gear for fishing, cleaning fish ready for export and for sale in the markets, general maintenance of the boat from acid washing the decks and brine tanks to preparing the vessel for out of sea surveys, also doing oil changes on 2 generators and the main engine, to keeping a safe watch whilst out at sea and insuring a safe mooring at port.
- **Hamilton Island Watersports** from February 2009 to March 2010. I was a deckhand on two 11.3 metre RIBS, a custom 10.2 metre fishing boat, a parasail boat and 2 ski boats it was in my job description to interact with my guests on all boats making sure they were all familiar with all the safety equipment, and what safety procedures where in place so that in the unlikely case of an emergency everybody on board was pre educated on what to do and how to be safe. Also informing guests on what was going to be involved on tours and giving demonstrations in front of large groups of people on how to perform such activities such as snorkeling, fishing, parasailing, skiing and wakeboarding. During this time I gained my restricted coxswains to the Whitsundays.
- **Commercial Fishing Vessel "The Shoalhaven"** fishing trawler on which I was a deckhand on for around 3 months. In that time I was required to maintain a safe watch whilst trawling, packing sorting and cleaning fish on the deck and also general maintenance and repairing of the boat when necessary
- **Ulladulla Fish CO-OP**, working on my weekends off and school holidays I was involved in the packing, sorting and loading of fish ready for export to Japan.
- **Topcom Excavations**, straight after completing my HSC I worked as a labourer in Canberra for Topcom, involved in this was recognising many live utility conduits, manual work such as digging trenches and the restoring of land to its original condition after completion. During this time I also gained some experience on many machines such as excavators, bobcats and backhoes.
