OBJECTIVES OF THE SBA

1. Creation of a forum through which members can obtain continuing education and upgrading of skills and knowledge through accreditation, trade nights, seminars, demonstrations and product promotions.
2. To develop and recognize code of work practice.
3. To foster consumer and government recognition through association self-regulation.
4. Provide a recognized identity for association members of all grades.

- ◆ Technical information, meetings and forums.
- ◆ Development of relevant business forms and stationery.
- ◆ Employment contact register, particularly suitable for casual tradesmen, sub-contractors or unemployed tradesmen and apprentices.
- ◆ Newsletters – keeping you informed and up to date with SBA news.
- ◆ Company participation opportunities at BIA boat shows and other marketing/promotional activities.
- ◆ Logo identification either at company or tradesperson levels.
- ◆ Social activities.
- ◆ Development of meaningful Code of Practice.

SBA MEMBERSHIP STRUCTURE

Membership of the SBA is available to people in the following two groups:

GROUP 1 – SBA AND BIA COMPANY MEMBERSHIP

This is available to companies being currently run by fully qualified (level 1) Shipwrights. This membership is extended to either the sole trader, partner or a director of a company who currently is fully qualified by way of Shipwright trade certificate from TAFE or equivalent training body (to be vetted) plus D.I.R.E. red card.

Full BIA fee's are applicable. \$220 joining fee plus \$392 membership fee.

GROUP 2 – SBA ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP LEVELS 1, 2 & 3

This provides all grades of Associate Membership with the benefits and services of SBA. SBA members with Level 1 qualifications and 5 years continuous trade experience or company Group 1, Level 1 membership qualifications with 2 years continuous company operation are eligible for SBA Board. SBA members from any grade would be eligible to sit in SBA sub-committees as formed from time to time.

GROUP 2 – LEVEL 1 (FULLY QUALIFIED TRADESPERSON)

Requirements: Completed the Shipwrights Trade Course and holding a Statement from TAFE, or equivalent training body (to be vetted), plus D.I.R.E. red card. Only members at this level may stand for President. Joining fee \$11.00 plus \$73.00 membership fee.

GROUP 2 – LEVEL 2 (TRADESPERSON)

Requirements: Completed the Shipwrights Trade Course and holding a Statement for TAFE or equivalent training body (to be vetted) or D.I.R.E. blue card. Joining fee \$11.00 plus \$63.00 membership fee.

GROUP 2 – LEVEL 3 (APPRENTICE)

Requirements: 1st & 2nd year apprentices must be indentured apprentices of the relevant shipwrights trade course and this level receives association information. Voting rights are not available. 3rd & 4th year apprentices receive association information and voting rights.

SBA Board positions are not available at this level. Apprentices no joining Fee and \$43.00 for the term of the apprenticeship.

RETIRED TRADESPERSONS who are no longer working within the industry in any capacity joining fee \$5.00 plus \$32.00 membership fee. SBA Board positions not available this level.

Access from LEVELS 2, 3 TO LEVEL 1 may be gained by either of the following:

1. Successful completion of the appropriate TAFE course, or
2. Obtaining DIRE recognition.

The membership criteria shown allows the following:

1. Companies that are run by shipwrights to advertise same and promote themselves by use of the logo.
2. Individuals to promote themselves through use of the logo.
3. Tradespeople who have either full qualifications or more than 5 years trade experience and red card equivalent or non formal trained experienced boat builders with DIRE recognition to all be regarded as Group 2 LEVEL 1 ASSOCIATE MEMBERS.
4. Tradespeople with less than 5 years experience and a TAFE statement only recognized tradespeople with more than 5 years experience but no dire recognition to be regarded as Group 2 LEVEL 2 ASSOCIATE MEMBERS.
5. Apprentices to gain membership as shown and are regarded as APPRENTICE ASSOCIATE MEMBERS.

This allows the genuine older tradesmen and the practicing non formally trained to be full members.

It also provides a goal for the more recent formally trained (though not qualified) and those practicing non formally trained to upgrade their membership category if they so choose. This also gives apprentices goals to aspire to.
