### The What & Why of MarineCard...

#### WHAT?

The 4-hour MarineCard OH&S General Induction course will be offered in your area soon. Participation in this brief training seminar by boating industry staff & contractors will help to build a better system of compliance, and improve the workplace health & safety performance of the industry.

#### WHY?

The OH&S legislation requires that controllers of access to commercial premises ensure that people entering those sites have a basic awareness of OH&S. This applies to workshops, marinas, slipways, boatyards, retail outlets etc., and anyone (ie: staff or contractors) who is technically "at work" when they are on the premises.

MarineCard provides a means for all boating industry businesses to manage these requirements. Focused on the risk profile of our industry, the MarineCard program is designed to increase awareness & streamline compliance.
