## PORT HAND MARKERS

Port hand markers are red and have a squared shaped topmark.
When dark, a port hand mark shows a flashing red light.
Can you see the port markers with the squared shape below.

## STARBOARD HAND MARKERS

Starboard hand markers are green and have a cone shaped topmark. When dark, a starboard hand mark shows a flashing green light. Can you see the starboard markers with the cone shapes above? Colour in the starboard hand markers and light their correct colour.

## NAVIGATING WATERWAYS

WHEN BOATING, THE SAFE SIDE TO PASS A LATERAL NAVIGATION MARKER IS DETERMINED BY YOUR DIRECTION OF TRAVEL TO OR FROM THE SEA


Keep green (starboard hand marks) on your left-hand side when going downstream


Keep green (starboard hand marks) on your right hand side when going upstream


Keep red (port hand marks) on your right hand side when going downstream


Keep red (port hand marks) on your left hand side when going upstream
