boating alone

Take extra care when boating alone. "boating alone" is considered a time of heightened risk and skippers should take the following precautions.

- Wear a lifejacket.
- Use a lanyard connected to the engine cut-off switch.
- Tell someone where you are going and estimated time of return.
- Check the weather.
- Ensure the boat is suitable for the conditions.
