Since 1 February 2009 your old 121.5 MHz analogue EPIRB is no longer detected by the search and rescue satellite. Switch to a digital 406 MHz distress beacon NOW.

Registration is free. Register your 406 MHz distress beacon with AMSA to assist the search and rescue response.
