

getting a boat licence



Any person who drives a recreational powered vessel on NSW waters at a speed of 10 knots or more must have a boat driver's licence.

Anyone wishing to sit for a general boat licence test must first complete a compulsory Boating Safety Course. You can do the course online, view a DVD or attend a Boating Safety Course. Once you have completed the course you receive a Certificate of Completion, which then allows you to sit the licence test. Log onto www.rms.nsw.gov.au/maritime for more information
