Missing safety gear, seized fittings, old fuel, a dead battery, torn sails or fraying rigging are just a few surprises for boaters returning to the water in the warmer spring weather.

Spring is a good time to give your vessel a seaworthiness check. Before operating any switches or engines, check for petrol or LPG odours. If your vessel has been lying idle over the winter months change over or freshen up your fuel. Contact your local BIA member to set you right.
