A travel plan for a boater is vitally important.

It may save your life and the life of your family and friends. When required, use your marine radio to log onto a coastal radio base before you leave. Tell them where you're going, how many people are aboard, what the boat looks like, it's name and when you expect to be back. Remember to log off when you return or report in if your trip is extended.
